



ELDAD SHREM

For over 30 years Eldad Shrem has been one of the first musicians in Israel, and has earned an important position in forming the Israeli musical entertainment trend, both on stage and TV/movies.

As a musical producer and director Eldad produced numerous records for singers and music groups in Israel and worldwide. Stage productions such as Hacol Over Habibi in the 70.s and on to stage successes all through the years after. Lately Eldad represented Israel in 4 Eurovision competitions as a director, composer and orchestration.

Eldad directed most of the famous musicals in Israel. To name just a few of them: Le Miserables, Chicago, Guys and Dolls, Westside Story, Evita, Cabaret, Blood Brothers, and many more. He also wrote some of the musicals, such as The City Boys, Don't Get Off Me, Blue-White in Colors and more.

As a member of the Israeli TV staff, Eldad was one of the first pioneers, acting as musical director / composer / orchestra director in each of the big entertainment programs on the TV station has produced. When the 2nd channel was grounded, He was appointed the musical director of the famous Dan Shilon Shoe, for years, and the popular show Dancing with the Stars.

In the past 6 years Eldad developed a very close cooperation with the Hebrewlites of Dimona, which produced some very successful productions such as the musical What a Wonderful World, a mutual concert with the Rishon Symphony Orchestra, a concert with the Kameri Orchestra, and various musical productions within his company Eldad Shrem Music.
